



Intimate Partner Violence Safety Planning Online Training Registration Form

The **Intimate Partner Violence Safety Planning Online Training** is a practical resource for support workers as they safety plan with survivors, their children, and families impacted by intimate partner violence.

This training replaces the *Domestic Violence Safety Planning Online Training* that was originally developed through a partnership between the [Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General](#) and [BC Housing](#), in collaboration with the [Ending Violence Association of BC](#), the [BC Society of Transition Houses](#), and the [Police Victim Services of BC](#). The course includes foundational elements and tools for safety planning that can be adapted to different circumstances.

Learners can use the training at their own pace, and it will require approximately 5–6 hours. The course consists of three modules:

- **Intimate Partner Violence and Approaches to Safety**
- **Working with Survivors to Develop Safety Plans**
- **Collaborating Across Sectors**

Each learner will have 90 days to complete the course.

Anyone wishing to register for the course should submit the attached registration form. Registrations will be accepted on an ongoing basis.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- The course will be available to support workers employed by Community Safety and Victim Services Branch-funded programs including:
 - Violence Against Women programs (e.g., Stopping the Violence Counselling; Prevention, Education, Advocacy, Counselling, and Empowerment (PEACE); Outreach Services; Multicultural Outreach Services; Sexual Assault Services; Sexual Assault Centres) and Victim Services programs

- Provincial Associations (BC Society of Transition Houses, Ending Violence Association of BC, Police Victim Services of BC)
- Child and Youth Advocacy Centres (CYAC)
- Have approval to take the training from their employer.
- Agree to complete the training within 90 days from initial log in to the course.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the next steps after the registration form is submitted?

After your registration form is processed, you will receive an e-mail with instructions on how to create your account and gain access to the training. After you log in to the course for the first time, you will have 90 days to complete the training.

Is there a charge for the training?

The Community Safety and Victim Services Branch covers the cost for the online course, but does not cover any additional costs associated with taking the training, e.g., worker time.

Will I receive a certificate for completing the training?

Each learner who completes the course will be able to download a certificate of completion from their dashboard.
