ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,  
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the  
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS the week of November 1 to 7, 2016, has been designated as Crime Prevention Week in British Columbia, and in recognition thereof, communities throughout the Province are actively participating in this event, and

WHEREAS the Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General and crime prevention groups throughout the Province wish to heighten public awareness of Crime Prevention Programs, and

WHEREAS the success of crime prevention depends on people working together in families, neighbourhoods, businesses, communities and youth groups to promote safer streets in every community, and

WHEREAS British Columbia encourages local governments to build strong communities that discourage crime and to work cooperatively with justice and law enforcement agencies, crime prevention groups, communities, schools, youth groups and businesses to build public awareness and involvement in crime prevention activities;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that the week of November 1 to 7, 2016, shall be known as

**“Crime Prevention Week”**

in the Province of British Columbia.
