DANGEROUS GOODS

On 06 Apr 14, a fuel tanker truck containing 15,000 litres of diesel and 13,000 litres of gasoline went off of Highway 3 near Princeton, and over an embankment coming to rest on its side near Whipsaw Creek. The highway was closed and there was a potential for material to spill to waterways that drain into river system that enters Washington State. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) until the product was safely off loaded.
