WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 14 - 20 APR 2014

FIRES

On 14 Apr 14, a task was issued to the Squamish Lillooet Regional District for their support to the FLNRO Wildfire Management Branch and Xwisten First Nations (Bridge River Indian Band) due to a wild land urban interface fire on the Bridge River Indian Reserve.

On 15 Apr 14, a task was issued for EMBC SWE Region for the purpose of tracking urban interface fire related responses for AANDC during the 2014 fire season.

On 15 Apr 14, an incident was created to track financial expenditures for the Bridge River Indian Band's response to a wild land urban interface fire (K70042) that required five homes be put on evacuation alert on 14 Apr.

On 16 Apr 14, an incident was created to track the response of Mt Currie First Nations when a wild land urban interface fire (V30007) destroyed one residence and posed a threat to 20 more homes. FLNRO Wildfire Management Branch sent crews to assist Mt Currie and Pemberton Fire Departments suppress the fire.

FLOODING

On 18 Apr 14, an event was opened in regards to the flooding of a residence at 1619 Spokane in Rossland as a result of a blocked or caved in culvert. TASK 150312

On 20 Apr 14, an event was opened for a mudslide that may be causing potential flooding 10 KM East of Hope along the Sumallo FSR. TASK 150351

BODY RECOVERY

On 14 Apr 14, Ridge Meadows SAR provided assistance for a body recovery in the Malcolm Knaff Research Forest. TASK 150267
