FLOODING

On 22 Apr 14, EMBC CTL activated their PREOC to address Spring Flood related issues in the region.

On 23 Apr 14, a debris flow incident on Macintyre Creek covered Sunny Brae Canoe Point Road and isolated approximately 40 residents. MOTi as the lead agency provided geotechnical assessment and requested Columbia Shuswap Regional District plan to prepare shuttle service as required for stranded residents. EOC activated at level 1.

On 24 Apr 14, the North Okanagan Regional District activated an EOC at level 1 to address flooding issues related to a land slide on Edgar Road.

On 24 Apr 14, the Village of Enderby activated their EOC at level 1 in response to flooding on the Shuswap River.

On 24 Apr 14, Lumby activated their EOC at level 1 in response to flooding.

EARTHQUAKE

On 24 Apr 14, an incident was opened to track costs associated with a 6.6 magnitude earthquake felt on the evening of April 23, 2014 off the West Coast of Vancouver Island.

BODY RECOVERY

On 25 Apr 14, Penticton SAR provided assistance for a body recovery from Channel Parkway in Okanagan Falls.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 22 Apr 14, Osoyoos/Oliver SAR responded to conduct an evidence search in the Bull Moose Way area of Osoyoos.
