EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 04 May 14, Comox Valley SAR conducted an evidence search at the request of the RCMP.

FLOODING

On 30 Apr 14, the District of West Kelowna activated their EOC to address potential flooding caused by erosion due to high water levels.

On 30 Apr 14, the North Okanagan Regional District (NORD) was issued an incident and task number to cover their response to flooding .

On 01 May 14, North Okanagan Regional District (NORD) opened an incident for the Enderby area after a large debris flow caused a road to be washed out and bridge to be damaged. TASK 150407

On 03 May 14, the Provincial Emergency Coordination Centre (PECC) was assigned a task number for Spring Freshet

On 04 May 14, the Okanagan-Similkameen Regional District (OSRD) was issued a task number following reports of flood related issues at Missezula Lake, Alison Lake, Tullameen and Hayes Creek.

On 04 May 14, the township of Langley received a task number to assist residents who were being affected by overland flooding.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 28 Apr 14, Nelson City responded to a bomb scare at the Nelson and Region Credit Union. The Credit Union and adjacent City Hall were evacuated by the Fire Department and Nelson City Police.

On 29 Apr 14, Salmon Arm Road Rescue Society responded to assist BCAS with a medical rescue after pedestrian was hit by a train on Highway 1, in Canoe BC.
