WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 07 – 13 APR 2014

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 08 Apr 14, Pacific Northern Gas Ltd experienced a minor leak on a high pressure natural gas line in the Thornhill area near Terrace which resulted in an evacuation of a neighbouring business. The OGC Duty Incident Commander coded the incident Level 2 based on the risk score. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer raised the incident to Code 2 (Urgent Status) due to the evacuation.

FLOODING

On 07 Apr 14, an event was open for the residents along Fyfe Road in West Lake in the Fraser Fort George Regional District. One home was affected due to snow melt.

On 08 Apr 14, The Peace River Regional District activated their EOC at Level 1 to address localized flooding issues caused by record melting snowpack.

On 09 Apr 14, the Regional District of East Kootenay activated their EOC to Level 1 in support of flooding issues at Elizabeth Lake.

INTERFACE FIRE

On 11 Apr 14, a task was issued to the PECC for the purpose of tracking wild land urban interface fire related responses during the 2014 fire season.
