## **WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 18-24 AUG 2014**

### **DGIR CODE 2**

On 22 Aug 14, an ammonia leak at the BC Frozen Foods plant in Mission resulted in the evacuation of the plant, closing of CP Rail, the Lougheed Hwy and areas of the Fraser River. The MOE RO (Ministry of Environment Response Officer) raised the incident to code 2 status. The leak was shut in and the ammonia cloud dispersed to atmosphere. The incident was downgraded after Fire Department on scene command declared an all clear.

### **BODY RECOVERY**

On 19 Aug 14, Squamish SAR, at the request of RCMP, provided the recovery of human remains from a gully on the south side of The Chief.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

On 21 Aug 14, Princeton Fire Rescue responded to BCAS request to provide medical assistance with moving a large individual from a trampoline.

On 24 Aug 14, Princeton Fire Rescue responded to BCAS request to provide medical assistance in moving a patient to the hospital.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL**

On 19 Aug 14, two slides occurred during a heavy rainfall event in the Pavillion area north of Lillooet. Lillooet Fire Rescue and Pemberton SAR teams responded at the request of RCMP to check for potentially trapped vehicles and persons affected. Five homes were checked for structural damage and one home was destroyed. The road was scheduled to be closed for two days in order to clear the slide.
