BODY RECOVERY

On 16 Dec 14, Castlegar SAR and Tarry's Fire Department members assisted RCMP with a body recovery off Thrums Road near Castlegar.

CODE 2

On 18 Dec 14, View Royal FD responded to a chemical spill at the Songhees First Nation. The Ministry of Environment raised the incident status to Urgent (Code 2) due to the liquid being Sodium Hydroxide, and the fact that 21 people were evacuated from their homes.

FLOOD

On 16 Dec 14, The City of Maple Ridge activated their EOC to mitigate the impacts of a landslide on Silver Valley Road.

On 17 Dec 14, EMBC SWE retroactively provided a task number to the Pemberton EOC that activated on 10 December to mitigate effects of severe storm flood conditions.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 16 Dec 14, Nakusp Fire Rescue responded to rescue two seriously injured patients involved in a snowmobile accident at 4958 Hwy 23.

On 20 Dec 14, Hope SAR responded to a BCAS request to create a landing zone for an inbound helicopter involved in rescuing patients involved in a snowmobile accident.
