ENVIRONMENTAL

On 08 Dec 14, EMBC SWE activated their PREOC to address flooding caused by a significant winter storm forecast for the lower mainland.

On 09 Dec 14, The City of Courtenay EOC (Emergency Operations Centre) activated to address localized flooding created by a significant rain fall event.

On 09 Dec 14, The Comox Valley Regional District (CVRD) activated to address localized flooding caused by a significant rain fall event.

On 09 Dec 14, The Corporation of Delta activated their EOC to address localized flooding caused by a significant rainfall event.

On 09 Dec 14, EMBC VIR activated their PREOC to address flooding caused by a significant winter storm event.

On 09 Dec 14, The City of Richmond activated their EOC to address flooding issues in the Historical area of Britannia.

On 09 Dec 14, the Regional District of Strathcona activated their EOC to Level 2 due to isolated flooding on the Oyster River.

On 09 Dec 14, the City of Campbell River activated their EOC to Level 2 due to potential flooding and evacuations in low-lying areas.

On 09 Dec 14, Nanaimo Regional District (NRD) activated their EOC in response flooding issues at French Creek and the Englishman River.

On 10 Dec 14, The PECC (Provincial Emergency Coordination Centre) activated in support of the SWE PREOC (Provincial Region Emergency Operation Centre) and VIR PREOC's dealing with the impacts caused by a severe Winter Storm.

On 10 Dec 14, The District of Vancouver activated their EOC to monitor Seymour River and other flood conditions associated with the storm event.

On 10 Dec 14, The City of North Van activated their EOC to monitor flood conditions of Mackay and various smaller creeks caused by storm event.

On 10 Dec 14, The District of West Van activated their EOC to monitoring rising tides in the applied area of Bellevue, combined residential and commercial, affected by flood conditions caused by storm event.

On 10 Dec 14, The Village of Lions Bay activated their EOC to address issues with two water intakes damaged and potentially affecting the water supply.

On 10 Dec 14, The Alberni/Clayoquot Regional District activated their EOC to address flooding of the Somass River impacting residential properties.

On 10 Dec 14, The Village of Cumberland activated their EOC to address localized flooding associated with a storm event.

On 10 Dec 14, The Tseshaht First Nations activated their response plan to assist residents evacuated from their homes because of flooding on the Somass River and McCoy Lake.

On 10 Dec 14, The Lower Stl'at'imx First Nations Council activated to support the community with issues associated with the storm event.

On 10 Dec 14, The District of Whistler activated their EOC to address flood related issues caused by a storm event.

On 10 Dec 14, The Powell River Regional District activated their EOC to address issues relating to a landslide after a storm event.

On 11 Dec 14, City of Nanaimo activated their EOC to address evacuations related to a sewage plant at Neck Point.

On 11 Dec 14, The Fraser Valley Regional District activated their EOC address dike repairs near 10491 Farms Road.

On 11 Dec 14, The Douglas First Nations in the Squamish Lillooet Regional District activated their EOC to initiate evacuation notices for two remote communities Tipella and Fort Douglas because of flooding.

On 11 Dec 14, The Cariboo Regional District activated their EOC to address flood conditions caused by an Ice jam in the Cottonwood River. A park, heritage site and up to a dozen homes were affected.

On 11 Dec. 14, the EPC for the Kootenay/Boundary RD responded to a landslide closing Highway 22A and parallel road 17 KM from Trail.

On 12 Dec 14, The Fraser Fort George Regional District activated their EOC to address flood concerns related to an Ice Jam on Naver Creek in the Hixon area.

On 12 Dec 14, The Hupacasath First Nations activated their response plan to assist 12 people evacuated from their homes because of flooding on the Somass River and storm conditions during a King Tide starting 09 December, 2014.

On 12 Dec 14, The Nanaimo Regional District activated their EOC to address issues related to Neck Point Sewage facility bordering the City of Nanaimo.

On 12 Dec 14, The Skatin First Nations responded to address flooding and access to their community.

On 12 Dec 14, The District of Powell River EOC activated to address the impact of a landslide on Atrevida Road that occurred post extreme storm event.

On 14 Dec 14, The Cariboo Regional District EOC activation addressed flood related issues dealing with a culvert and road wash out.
