WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 24 FEB-02 MAR 2014

SEVERE STORM

On 24 Feb 14, a severe winter storm over the Southern Gulf Island resulted in heavy snowfall that caused road access issues and an extended power outage. The Capital Regional District activated their EOC to Level 1 to provide support and coordination of local response on the island.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 27 Feb 14, a gas leak was detected in a residential town house complex in the District of Sparwood that resulted in the evacuation of 160 units. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status). The Sparwood Fire Department closed the road to restrict access to and from the area. Ventilation fans were used inside the building to keep the gas levels below the explosive limit while Fortis excavated and made repairs.
