EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 13 Jan 14, Metchosin and Saanich SAR were requested by Victoria Police to assist them with an evidence search in Beacon Hill Park.

FLOODING

On 14 Jan 14, local flooding in the town site of Stewart overloaded the storm and sewer system resulting in ground water & sewage to be discharged in to the Bear River. Crews were tasked with preparing sandbags to protect infrastructure and to have available for home owners if required.

LANDSLIDE

On 13 Jan 14, the Nisga'a Nation EOC was activated in New Aiyansh in support of Kincolith after a landslide isolated the community.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 14 Jan 14, Squamish Emergency Program activated their EOC to Level 1 in support of the response coordination for a significant diesel spill caused by the sinking of a tug boat at the Squamish Yacht Club.

On 15 Jan 14, Northern Rockies Regional Municipality opened a warming centre for residents impacted by a power outage in the area.

On 15 Jan 14, District of Tumbler Ridge opened a warming centre for residents impacted by a power outage in the area.
