WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 06 - 12 JAN 2014

DANGEROUS GOODS

On Jan 11, 2014 a CP Train derailed from a CP track in Burnaby. Three of the seven rail cars that were impacted, overturned and dumped loaded coal into a nearby creek which had undercut the tracks due to heavy rain. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) while clean up was conducted and the tracks repaired.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 12 Jan 14, RCMP requested Pemberton SAR assist with an evidence search in Pemberton Village.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 07 Jan 2014, a residence was evacuated in Langford after a carbon monoxide leak was discovered. 3 people were provided accommodation for the night.
