URBAN INTERFACE FIRE

On 14 Jul 14, the Central Okanagan Regional District activated their EOC due to an evacuation alert that was issued for an interface fire K50249 threatening homes in the Smith Creek Road and Copper Ridge Drive area of West Kelowna. Municipal Fire Departments and the Wildfire Management Branch were able to contain the fire and the EOC stood down.

On 14 Jul 14, the Bulkley Nechako Regional District were advised of an evacuation alert that was issued for a wildfire R10070 threatening recreational properties southeast of Tetchuck Lake.

On 15 Jul 14, an incident was generated for the Peace River Regional District as they activated to provide support for response to an interface fire G70221 on Mount McAllister near Hudson Hope.

On 15 Jul 14, the Thompson Nicola Regional District (TNRD) requested a task number in response to an interface fire K60265 burning between Juliet Creek and Murray Lake. An evacuation order was issued to approximately 30 recreational cabins that were at risk in the area.

On 15 Jul 14, an incident was generated for Kelowna to activate their EOC in response to the Mount Boucherie Fire K50273.

On 15 Jul 14, an incident was generated for the Hudson's Hope District as they activated in response to an interface fire G70221 on Mount McAllister.

On 15 Jul 14, an incident was generated for the West Moberly First Nations as they were put under evacuation alert due to an interface fire G70221 on Mount McAllister.

On 15 Jul 14, an incident was generated for the Saulteau First Nations as they were put under evacuation alert due to an interface fire G70221 on Mount McAllister. G70221

On 16 Jul 14, an incident was generated for Dawson Creek as they activated their EOC to plan and prepare to receive the residents evacuated due to the interface fire G70221 on Mount McAllister near Hudson Hope.

On 16 Jul 14, an incident was generated for the OSRD when they activated in response to an interface fire K60286 burning in the Bankier Chain Lakes area between Princeton and Summerland.

On 16 Jul 14, an incident was generated for the OSRD when they activated to provide support for response to an interface fire K50286 burning in the Nickelplate Boot Hill area near Penticton.

On 16 Jul 14, an incident was generated for the OSRD when they activated in response to an interface fire K60286 burning in the Jura area between Missezula Lake and the Summerland Princeton Road area.

On 17 Jul 14, RCMP requested assistance from Kent Harrison SAR with a tactical evacuation of cabins near the mouth of the Harrison River at the south end of Harrison Lake due to a threat from an interface fire V10265.

On 17 Jul 14, an incident was opened for the Fraser Valley Regional District to activate their EOC as a result of an interface fire V10237 in the Mahattle Valley near Boston Bar.

On 17 Jul 14, an incident was opened for Central Okanagan Regional District (CORD) who activated their EOC in response to evacuation notices served to residents of the District of West Kelowna threatened by an interface fire K50293.

On 17 Jul 14, Cariboo Regional District (CRD) opened an incident for a wildfire burning at the 34 kilometre mark on Red Road near Tatelkuz Lake.

On 17 Jul 14, an incident was opened for the Peace River Regional District (PRRD) in response to an interface fire G60096 burning at Forres Mountain.

On 17 Jul 14, an AANDC incident was opened for a Tsay Keh Dene First Nations community affected by the Forres Mountain wildfire G60096.

On 17 Jul 14, an incident was opened for Kitimat District to activate their EOC due to a wildfire burning south of Kitimat.

On 17 Jul 14, the CTL PREOC authorized a task number be generated for AANDC Fire Season 2014.

On 17 Jul 14, an incident was opened for the Lytton First Nations due to the potential threat of evacuation resulting from the Botanie Fire K70270.

On 19 Jul 14, an incident was opened due to an interface fire K20298 that broke out overnight and burned 4 heritage homes in Ashcroft. An Evacuation Order and Alert were issued and later rescinded when the fire was brought under control.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 18 Jul 14, 7 adults in an apartment building in Abbotsford were provided with alternate accommodations, food and incidentals after their building was impacted by a vehicle and suffered structural damage.
