## **WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT MAR 3-9, 2014**

### **FLOODING**

On 06 March, 2014 EMBC SEA activated their PREOC in support of local government dealing with overland flooding issues related to recent warming temperatures.

On 06 March, 2014 the East Kootenay Regional District activated an EOC in Cranbrook to respond to numerous areas that were impacted by overland flooding caused by rain and warming temperatures. Sand bags and sand were provided to residents in Wasa, Wardner, Elk Valley, Canal Flats and the City of Cranbrook.

On 06 March, 2014 the Central Kootenay Regional District activated their EOC to level 1 in response to overland flooding caused by rain and warming temperatures in Creston.

On 06 March, 2014 St Mary's Indian Band (IR#1) were provided sand and sand bags to respond to flooding when Joseph Creek crested it's banks and significant overland water threatened homes.

On 07 March, 2014 the Provincial Emergency Operations Centre (PECC) activated to support the Regional Operation Centres that were providing support to local governments responding to overland flooding.

On 07 March, 2014 North Okanagan Regional District activated their EOC in response to overland flooding in both Lumby and Coldstream.

On 07 March, 2014 a task number was issued for AANDC for flood response in the Central Region. Okanagan First Nations were provided sand and sand bags to protect homes in the Coyote Creek area.

On 07 March, 2014 District of Summerland provided sand and sandbags for localized flooding.

On 07 March, 2014 the East Kootenay Regional District expanded their response to overland flooding to include the communities of Kimberley, Fort Steel, Cranbrook and the Elk Valley.

On 09 March, 2014 the ongoing warm weather resulted with an inundation of water running over frozen ground over a period of days and the East Kootenay Regional District opened a second EOC in Fernie to respond to multiple flooding incidents in the communities of Gold Creek, Jaffray, Fernie, Hosmer, Cokato and Wycliffe.

### **LANDSLIDE**

On 06 March, 2014 the Lions Bay District activated their EOC in response to landslides that had occurred on Harvey Creek and Magnesia Creek due to a heavy rainfall event.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

On 03 March, 2014 Creston Fire rescue responded outside of their fire protection area to rescue a person that was reported to be trapped in a structure that was on fire.

On 03 March, 2014 the community of Warfield activated their EOC to Level 1 in response to a MVI that caused a hazmat issue.
