WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 12 – 18 May 2014

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 12 May 14, Chinook Energy 2010 Inc. experienced a fire that involved two 400 barrel tanks of crude oil at their producing facility located 120 kilometers north of Fort St John. The site was evacuated and the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status). The Oil and Gas Commission responded to the site. H2S monitors indicated no ambient H2S levels during the event and all contamination was kept to site property. The incident was downgraded once the fire was extinguished.

BODY RECOVERY

On 17 May 14, 5 Lillooet Rescue members recovered a body from under the bridge in Lillooet and turned it over to the Coroner.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 13 May 14, Mission SAR responded to a request by RCMP to perform an evidence search near the Hayward Lake Recreation Site.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 14 May 14, North Shore Rescue was requested to perform a pet rescue in the Capilano River.

On 16 May 14, Nanaimo Fire Rescue responded to assist BCAS with a medical rescue of a dirt biker who was suffering with a compound knee fracture and head injury.

FLOOD

On 16 May 14, EMBC SWE activated their PREOC in support of regional flooding activity.

On 18 May 14, the East Kootenay Regional District was issued an incident and task number to cover their response to flooding.
