BODY RECOVERY

On 27 May 14, New Denver SAR responded to an RCMP request to retrieve three bodies from Slokan Lake.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 26 May 14, the EMBC Regional Duty Manager approved a task for WorkSafeBC and liability coverage only, after Squamish SAR members responded in good faith to a page without a request from an approved tasking agency. The call involving an unconscious infant locked in a vehicle in the Squamish Town Centre. The infant was assessed by BCAS and released to the mother.

On May 29 14, Ladysmith Fire Rescue responded to assist BCAS with providing medical rescue of an anaphylaxis patient located beyond the locked gate at Stocking Lake. Fire unlocked the gate and BCAS was able to drive to the lake however, the subject had already walked out to a local school for medical attention.

FLOOD

On 26 May 14, East Kootenay Regional District (EKRD) activated their Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) to a level 1 in support flood response activities in the Sparwood District.

On 26 May 14 a task number was issued to Central Kootenay Regional District (CKRD) for response activities due to flooding issues in the Balfour area.

On 26 May 14 the Southeast Provincial Regional Emergency Operations Centre (SEA PREOC) was activated in support of those local governments involved with flood response activities.

On 30 May 14, a task number was issued to the Fraser Valley Regional District (FVRD) to support a flood response in the Laidlaw Area.
