On 08 May 14, Merritt SAR responded to an RCMP request for an evidence search in Monk Provincial Park.

FLOODING

On 05 May 14, flooding of Hayes Creek resulted in a bridge wash out on the Princeton Summerland Road in the Okanagan Similkameen Regional District (OSRD).

On 05 May 14, Violet Creek overflowed its banks causing manure to wash into the Shuswap River from a farm field on Meadow View Road in the North Okanagan Regional District (NORD).

On 05 May 14, a task number was issued to track Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC) costs related to flood response for First Nations communities in the Central (CTL) Region.

On 05 May 14, the Adams Lake Indian Band began to deliver sandbags to those properties at highest risk of freshet flooding.
