**DANGEROUS GOODS**

On 20 Nov 14, the North Okanagan Regional District (NORD) Emergency Social Service (ESS) team assisted evacuated residents near Lavington who were displaced due to a Fortis Main Line natural gas leak. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO). The residents were allowed to return home after pipeline repairs were completed by Fortis and the Fire Department deemed their residences safe for entry when air monitoring results were clear.
