WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT – Nov. 24-30

ENVIRONMENTAL

On 28 Nov 14, the Fraser Valley Regional District (FVRD) activated their EOC in response to flooding in Yale as a result of a storm event that went through the region the previous night.

On 30 Nov 14, the Village of Pemberton activated their EOC to address flooding and infrastructure damage due to an ice jam in Pemberton Creek.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 26 Nov 14, Emergency Social Services was requested by the Agassiz Deputy Fire Chief to assist a mother and young child that were evacuated because of high carbon monoxide levels in the home. One night accommodation was provided to the evacuees.

On 26 Nov 14, the city of Prince Rupert activated their EOC in response to a bomb threat in the downtown core. Police, Fire and City crews responded and evacuated a portion of the area surrounding a Safeway.

On 26 Nov 14, Emergency Social Services assisted 4 people evacuated from their home because of high carbon monoxide levels.

On 28 Nov 14, Emergency Social Services was requested by the Sparwood Fire Department to open a warming center to accommodate motorists stranded because of highways closures during a severe winter storm.

On 28 Nov 14, Emergency Social Services was requested by the Fernie Fire Department to assist 6 people evacuated from their home because of high carbon monoxide levels.
