WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 03 Nov – 09 Nov 2014

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 04 Nov 14, the City of Langley Fire Department reported a vessel was sinking and fully engulfed at Derby Reach with an estimated 3,000 liters of diesel on board. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO).

On 06 Nov 14, a motor vehicle incident involving a transport truck moving ammonium nitrate caught fire on the TransCanada Highway (TCH), east of Savona. The community of Tobiano was tactically evacuated as a precautionary measure because of the explosive nature of the load. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO.

On 06 Nov 14, Chevron Burnaby Refinery reported a mud slide in Confederation Park which was running along their right of way into Rainbow Creek and then into Burrard Inlet. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO when it was learned that the slide had exposed 15 individual buried pipelines that transfer gasoline and diesel fuel.

ENVIRONMENTAL

On 03 Nov 14, a debris flow caused overland flooding of 15 to 20 homes in the North Vancouver area. The North Shore Emergency Measures Office activated their EOC to Level 1 to coordinate the response and evacuation of the impacted residences.

On 06 Nov 14, The District of West Vancouver retroactively initiated a task to address impacted assets caused by the storm event 03 November, 2014.

On 08 Nov 14, a landslide occurred at the Bridal Falls Campground in the Fraser Valley Regional District. A tactical evacuation of 51 people was conducted.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 06 Nov 14, North Shore Rescue responded to assist RCMP with an evidence search in the District of West Vancouver.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 06 Nov 14, the Thompson Nicola Regional District (TNRD) opened a reception center for residents who were tactically evacuated due to the incident involving the transport truck carrying ammonium nitrate that was on fire on the TCH east of Savona.

On 09 Nov 14, Chetwynd opened their EOC and established warming centers in support of the city losing power after a coal truck took out power lines and poles for the city.
