WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 20 – 26 Oct 2014

DEBRIS FLOW

On 22 Oct 14, Lions Bay activated their EOC in response to a debris flow that took out the main water intake at the top of Harvey Creek. Water distribution was cut off to half of the Village and the debris flow blocked access to the site. A Boil Water Advisory was issued for the Village due to high turbidity levels.

FLOOD

On 22 Oct 14, Sliammon Creek near Powell River overflowed its banks due to heavy rainfall and debris in the river damaging the fish hatchery operated by the Sliammon First Nation. A helicopter was used to remove some logs from the river and the situation will be monitored through the weekend.

On 23 Oct 14, The City of Coquitlam ESS level 2 response team responded to assess the needs of 16 residents displaced because of localized flooding caused by a blocked culvert impacted by a stream during a storm event.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 25 Oct 14, Ministry of Health Duty Officer (MOH DO) notified EMBC of a bomb threat that had been called in for an inbound Westjet flight to Kelowna. Communications with the aircraft were lost as well. Further information came to light and it turned out that the bomb was not on an inbound flight but was scheduled to leave on another flight. The RCMP was engaged, and there was no EMBC or Local Emergency Program involvement required. No task number was issued.
