CODE 2

On 28 Oct 14, the City of Vancouver activated their EOC in response to an apartment evacuation due to reports of a sulfur odor at 485 West 8th street affecting approximately 160 people and 20 of their pets. The Vancouver ESS team provided temporary shelter to the displaced residents and the Vancouver Fire Department Hazmat team investigated. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the level of the incident to Code 2 (urgent status). The building was later cleared by the Vancouver Fire Department and residents returned.

On 30 Oct 14, The Lilydale Poultry Processing plant in Port Coquitlam reported a 1" ammonia gas line rupture. Over 200 employees were evacuated and BCAS and Port Coquitlam Fire Department responded. The Ministry of the Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the level of the incident to Code 2 (urgent status). The Port Coquitlam Fire Department Hazmat team and Work Safe BC provided site control until the building was cleared for entry.

FLOOD

On 31 Oct 14, the Columbia Shuswap Regional District activated their EOC at level 1 to address potential flooding of Pinaus Lake and impacting a local fishing lodge.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 28 Oct 14, the Fort St John Fire Rescue department responded outside of their response area to rescue a 14 yr old male who sustained a leg injury when he went over an embankment.
