BODY RECOVERY

On 08 Oct 14, Terrace SAR members responded assist the Coroner to recover a deceased female from the Skeena River just north of Terrace.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 11 Oct 14, the Langley RCMP requested the assistance of Central Fraser Valley SAR for an evidence search on the Nicomekl River.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 10 Oct 14, Mission SAR requested CISM for a SAR member who was the first on scene following a MVI on the Lougheed Highway. RCMP requested the SAR member stay at the scene with a subject that had suffered serious injuries, who later died as a result of the injuries.

INTERFACE FIRE

On 11 Oct. 2014 an interface fire (K70634) potentially threatened several homes on the Lytton First Nations Reserve. The Band EPC activated their EOC in the Band Office. Wildfire Management Branch responded with an 8 person crew and determined that the fire behavior was not a concern and the fire was under control. No evacuation was necessary.
