## **WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 22-28 SEP 2014**

### **BODY RECOVERY**

On 22 Sep 14, Central Cariboo SAR responded to assist the RCMP with the recovery of human remains near Likely.

On 28 Sep 14, Ridge Meadows SAR responded to assist the RCMP with locating and recovering human remains in the Kinaka Creek area of Maple Ridge.

On 28 Sep 14, Nanaimo SAR were requested by RCMP to assist in the recovery of human remains found in the Millstone river.

### **DANGEROUS GOODS**

On 24 Sep 14, Fortis BC responded to a report of an explosive gas buildup affecting 10-12 residences in Surrey. The residents of the homes were evacuated temporarily while Fortis BC isolated the problem. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO). Once the problem had been dealt with by Fortis BC the residents were allowed back into their homes.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

On 25 Sep 14, a culvert overflowed in Ladysmith and flooded a senior's complex. Two night's accommodation was approved for the impacted residents.
