**WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 29 Sep – 05 Oct 2014**

**DANGEROUS GOODS**

On 04 Oct 14, 10 homes in Saanich District along Wilkinson and Burnside Road West suffered flood damage from a broken water main that resulted in a spill of 2 million gallons of chlorinated water to flow to Portage Inlet. A large sinkhole developed resulting in a road closure. Power was disrupted to two homes and although no formal evacuation was conducted, the community activated their EOC to Level 1 and a Comfort Centre was established. A number of residents were provided with alternate accommodation. The incident was upgraded to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) until the water main was shut off and repairs were underway.

**BODY RECOVERY**

On 02 Oct 14, Stewart SAR and Terrace SAR responded to assist the RCMP with the recovery of a deceased fisherman from the Cranberry River near Stewart.
