**WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 06 APR – 12 APR 2015**

**FLOOD**

On 10 Apr 15, the community of Lumby activated their EOC in response to flooding from a nearby creek/river.

**DANGEROUS GOODS (CODE 2)**

On 08 Apr 15, an estimated 2,700 liters of bunker fuel spilled to English Bay causing a sheen that expanded throughout the harbor. The leak was suspected to have come from an anchored cargo vessel. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO). Canadian Coast Guard, the lead agency continues to be supported by the Integrated ICP activated in Port Metro Vancouver's Operations Centre. Unified Command is in place with Canadian Coast Guard, West Coast Marine Response Centre, Polaris Applied Sciences, Port Metro Vancouver, BC Ministry of Environment, EMBC, City of Vancouver, North Shore Emergency Management, and Tsleil Waututh First Nation.

**MISCELLANEOUS**

On 09 Apr 15, the City of Vancouver and District of North Vancouver opened their EOCs in response to a bunker fuel spill in English Bay.

On 09 Apr 15, District of Mission ESS level 1 responded to assist 3 families displaced from their homes by a sewer back up.

**INTERFACE FIRE**

On 11 Apr 15, FLNRO advised of a 4-5 ha. Interface fire near Missezula Lake. 13 WMB personnel and a helicopter responded. The closest structure was reported to be within 100 metres.
