WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 17 – 23 Aug 2015

DANGEROUS GOODS (CODE 2)

On 18 Aug 15, a tractor trailer that was transporting hydrochloric acid was involved in a motor vehicle incident at the intersection of Likely Road and Highway 97, 150 Mile House. The driver was deceased and several of the containers of hydrochloric acid were broken allowing material to leak through the roof of the trailer. The highway was closed and a HAZMAT Team was called to the scene. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) who also responded and helped coordinate efforts between the Local Emergency Program, Interior Health, the RCMP, MoTI Highway Maintenance Contractor and the Trucking Company.

On 20 Aug 15, a 200' x 25' light diesel slick was noticed off shore of Vancouver from Second Beach Pool to the Kitsilano Pool. The incident was upgraded to Code 2 by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO), due to the potential for heightened media attention. The Coast Guard attended and determined that the sheen was unrecoverable and was dissipating.

On 23 Aug 15, a rainbow sheen was noticed extending from just past the Burrard Street Bridge to the marker buoy past the Kits Base, False Creek. The incident was upgraded to Code 2 by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO), due to the potential for heightened public and media attention. The Coast Guard investigated and found that the sheen was unrecoverable.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 22 Aug 15, Terrace SAR transported RCMP members up the Skeena River to check a cabin for evidence.

URBAN INTERFACE FIRES

On 22 Aug 15, Kootenay Boundary Regional District opened their EOC to support response to the wildfire in Paulson Pass (N60590).

On 23 Aug 15, Capitol RD opened their EOC to level one in response to a wildfire on Otter Point Road in Sooke (V60448) that resulted in the evacuation of 6 families.
