WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 31 AUG–06 SEP 2015

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 31 Aug 15, there was an oil sheen reported in False Creek in Vancouver. It was upgraded to Code 2 (Urgent Status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO). The Coast Guard investigated and determined that the sheen was non-recoverable. No source was located.

DEBRIS FLOW

On 04 Sep 15, a debris flow into an unnamed creek at Gates Lake caused localized flooding that threatened 2 residences, a historical building and the Birken Fire Hall. The Squamish Lillooet Regional District requested a task to cover engineering and construction costs to move the creek back to its original channel and reduce the threat to the at risk properties.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 04 Sep 15, North Shore Rescue were tasked by the RCMP to conduct an evidence search on the Howe Sound Crest Trail.

On 06 Sep 15, Ridge Meadows SAR were called out by RCMP to perform an evidence search on the east side of Alouette Lake.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 31 Aug 15, Princeton Rescue responded to a medical assistance request from BCAS in regards to a patient in cardiac arrest.

On 31 Aug 15, a low income housing complex owned by the City of Vancouver was flooded, displacing 160 people. ESS responded and three group lodging centres were established.

On 05 Sep 15, Fort St. John Fire Department responded to assist BCAS with a patient in cardiac arrest.

On 06 Sep 15, the Comox Fire Department Hazmat Crew were asked to assist Fanny Bay Fire Department with extricating a deceased person from a vehicle containing unknown chemicals.
