WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT July 6-12, 2015

BODY RECOVERY

On 12 July 15, Robson Valley SAR responded assist the RCMP to recover the body of an ATV rider that went over an embankment on Kinbasket Lake Road East in Valemount.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 07 July 15, Campbell River SAR responded at the request of the RCMP to conduct an evidence search in the Elk River Trail wooded area.

On 09 July 15, Nelson SAR and South Columbia SAR responded to an evidence search in the 110 block of West Innes Street in Nelson.

LANDSLIDE

On 11 July 15, a representative from TECK Mining - Line Creek Operations, reported a landslide in a canyon on the lease property near Sparwood. The debris flow had slid across and into Line Creek reducing the flow of water. The Regional District of East Kootenay Emergency Program Coordinator was advised and representatives from the Ministry of Energy and Mines and FLNRO, Water Stewardship were apprised of the situation. A helicopter overflight assessment by a Geotech was planned.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 09 Jul 15, Ness Lake Fire Rescue and Fort George Highway Rescue responded to assist a worker that was trapped under a front end loader/dozer at the 3km mark of Kay Kay FSR, near Saxton Lake, Prince George. Teams were stood down as first responders on scene performed the rescue.

URBAN INTERFACE FIRES

On 06 July 15, a task number was created to support wildfire response activities in the SWE region during the 2015 Fire Season.

On 06 July 15, an AANDC task number was issued for VIR to track response/support costs associated with First Nations impacted by wildfires during the 2015 Fire Season.

On 08 Jul 15, Cariboo Regional District activated their EOC in response to tactical evacuations that were conducted as a result of the Puntzi Lake Fire (C50146). An Evacuation Order was issued for residences on the northwest side of Puntzi Lake and an Evacuation Alert was issued for the southwest and north shores of the lake. Several structures were lost when the fire quickly grew due to extreme fire behaviour. The CRD expanded the Evacuation Order and Alert areas accordingly.

On 09 July 15, the Fraser Valley Regional District opened an EOC in response to the Cougar Creek Fire (V10247) at Mahatlatch Lake.

On 9 July 15, the Nanaimo Regional District opened an EOC in response to an urban interface fire in Coombs. No evacuations were required and the fire was in final mop up later that evening.

On 11 July 15, the Central Kootenay Regional District opened an EOC in response to a fire at Mount Aylwin (N50341), south of Silverton. Wildfire Services assessed the fire and determined that it posed no immediate threat to nearby residences.

On 11 July 15, an AANDC task number was issued for the NEA Region to track response costs associated with First Nations impacted by wildfire. An EOC was activated by the Alexis Creek Band at the Cultural Centre when approximately 300 residents were placed under evacuation alert due to the Puntzi Lake Fire.
