## **WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Nov 02 – 08 2015**

### **DANGEROUS GOODS**

On 02 Nov 15, there was a report of a brownish oily substance in the Fraser River under the Granville Street bridge in Vancouver. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) due to the potential for heightened media attention.

On 02 Nov 15, a small airplane crashed into the Courtenay River after clipping a fence. The two occupants survived and walked away from the crash. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) due to the potential for heightened media attention.

On 02 Nov 15, a 20 – 30 foot pleasure craft sunk at a private dock on the northeast side of Bedwell Bay in the Belcarra area of Indian Arm. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) due to the potential for heightened media attention.

On 04 Nov 2015, an overflying aircraft noted oil leaking from a pleasure craft in Porpoise Bay of Sechelt. The incident was upgraded to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO due to the potential for heightened media attention.

On 04 Nov 2015, a rainbow sheen was seen coming from fishing vessels tied up at Main Street dock in Vancouver Harbour. The incident was upgraded to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO due to the potential for heightened media attention.

On 04 Nov 2015, a diesel slick was noted at Health Bay near Gilford Island. It was believed to be coming from a nearby Fishing Vessel. The incident was upgraded to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO due to the potential for heightened media attention.

On 06 Nov 2015, a fuel sheen was reported in Anderson Cove in East Sooke. The incident was upgraded to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO due to the potential for heightened media attention.

On 06 Nov 2015, a fuel sheen was reported in the Horseshoe Bay area of West Vancouver. The Fire Department responded and boomed a 20' X 20' area which contained the spill. The incident was upgraded to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO due to the potential for heightened media attention.

On 08 Nov 2015, a large diesel sheen was located in Sidney's Westport Marina. No source was located. The incident was upgraded to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO due to the potential for heightened media attention.

On 08 Nov 2015, a diesel sheen was reported to be coming from the Queen of Sidney in the Fraser River near the intersection of Cooper Avenue and Chestnut Street in Mission. The incident was upgraded to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO due to the potential for heightened media attention.

On 08 Nov 2015, the Deep Cove Sailing club reported a 100 foot sheen around a 40 foot pleasure craft in Deep Cove near Indian Arm. The incident was upgraded to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO due to the potential for heightened media attention.

**MISCELLANEOUS**

On 05 Nov 2015, a task was issued to cover volunteers for liability and WCB when they responded to assist residents who were being evacuated by police while they searched for a person that had swum to shore on Galiano Island.
