WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 23 – 29 Nov 2015

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 28 Nov 15, Campbell River and Comox Valley SAR groups were requested by the RCMP to re-search a prior area of interest where human remains were found back on July 7th 2015.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 24 Nov 15, a slick was observed in Vancouver, west of English Bay. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to possible pollution and heightened media attention. The spill was ascertained to be organic and non-hydrocarbon based.

On 24 Nov 15, the motor vessel North Star lost propulsion due to an electrical problem and was bouncing around in 8 foot seas with winds gusting above 16 Knots. Repairs were being carried out at sea. Partial repairs were made and the ship was proceeding at a speed of 2.4 knots. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the potential pollution of the marine environment.

On 24 Nov 15, the Fishing Vessel Viking Storm released under 100 litres of diesel to the marine in French Creek Harbour near Parksville. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the quantity that entered the marine environment. Subsequently, the French Creek Lifeboat crew assisted in the cleanup of the spilled diesel.

On 25 Nov 15, a tanker truck spilled 2,000 litres of gasoline while filling the tanks of a gas station in Coldstream. The local Fire Department conducted a tactical evacuation of two nearby homes and established a 300 metre safety perimeter. Upon a site assessment carried out by RAM Environmental incident was raised by the MOE RO to Code 2 (urgent status) due to potential for pollution to impact Kalamalka Lake and heightened media attention.

On 26 Nov 15, a slick was observed in Vancouver, west of English Bay. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the possible pollution and heightened media attention. The spill was determined to be the same incident as reported on 24 Nov.

On 27 Nov 15. Sechelt First Nations reported that they had a 65 foot landing craft aground near the Selma Park breakwater. The vessel was leaking diesel into the marine environment. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the pollution to the marine environment. The Fire Department and CCG responded to take measures to stop the release, contain the spill and conduct clean up.

On 28 Nov 15, a citizen reported to the City of Vancouver Environmental Protection line that they noticed an oil sheen in Coal Harbour near Stanley Park. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the potential for heightened media attention.

On 29 Nov 15, a citizen reported that there was a slick (100m wide 4-5m long) of grey sludge and oil underneath the marina in Yaletown. No concrete source was evident as there were many vessels in the area. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (Urgent status).

On 29 Nov 15, a citizen reported to the City of Vancouver Environmental Protection line that they noticed an oil slick and grey sludge underneath the marina on False Creek. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the potential for heightened media attention.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 23 Nov 15, Lake Country Fire was requested by BCAS to respond to rescue an injured person over an embankment on Beaver Lake Road.

On 25 Nov 15, a reception centre was set up in Coldstream to accommodate residents that were evacuated due to a spill of 2000 litres of gasoline at a neighbouring gas station. Residents within a 300 metre safety perimeter were evacuated until the spill was contained and it was safe for residents to reenter the area.

On 28 Nov 15, 100 Mile Rescue responded with extrication tools, following a report of a child stuck in a washing machine in 108 Mile. The team took the washing machine apart and freed the child.
