WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 08 – 14 June 2015

BODY RECOVERY

On 08 June 15, Coquitlam and Ridge Meadows SAR responded to assist RCMP recovering the body of a deceased boater from the Pitt River.

URBAN INTERFACE FIRES

On 11 June 15, Kamloops Fire Centre reported a fire (K70122) in the Lytton area within the Thompson Nicola Regional District between two First Nations communities. An Evacuation Alert and Order were implemented for the communities along the west side of the Fraser River.

On 11 Jun 15, Lytton First Nations government activated an EOC to address evacuation recommendations by the Kamloops Fire Centre for residents threatened by an interface fire in the Lytton area. (K70122).

On 12 Jun 15, North Okanagan Regional District opened an EOC in support of the interface fire (K40126) that threatened Kalamalka Lake Provincial Park in Cosens Bay/Coldstream.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 14 June 15, SAR members from Nelson, South Columbia and Kimberly were returning from a training task when they witnessed a motor vehicle incident. Members administered first responder medical aid to the subjects. One subject did not survive, and SAR members were provided CISM.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 11 June 15, an ammonia leak occurred at the Beban Park Public Pool in Nanaimo resulting in an evacuation of the facility including 3 employees that were taken to the hospital for observation. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status). The MOE RO attended and obtained air samples which contained no traces of ammonia vapors, and the facility was subsequently re-opened for public use.
