**WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 01 – 03 April 2016**

**DANGEROUS GOODS (CODE 2)**

On April 1, 2016 a semi-derelict tug sank at anchor, pulling another vessel along with it in Deep Bay resulting in a strong smell of diesel and a heavy sheen in the bay. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the ecological sensitivity of the area and the potential for heightened media attention. The Coast Guard attended and placed containment booms around the vessels and will continue to monitor the situation.

**MISCELLANEOUS**

On April 2, 2016 Penticton SAR was tasked to assist BCAS with access to a patient with possible head injury at Lake 2 at the Headwaters Fishing camp in Summerland District. SAR members were stood down when BCAS advised that a private individual brought the subject out.
