## **WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 25 Apr – 01 May**

### **DANGEROUS GOODS (CODE 2)**

On 26 Apr, 2016 a semi-trailer was involved in a motor vehicle incident and went down 100 feet down an embankment on Highway 5 south of Kamloops. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status), due to the potential environmental impact and driver fatality.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

On 30 Apr 16, Prince Rupert SAR provided RCMP assistance with an evidence search in wooded area along Park Ave.

### **FLOODING**

On 25 Apr 16, a task was issued to the Squamish Lillooet Regional District to activate their EOC in support of an imminent flood risk in the Seaton Portage and Anderson Lake area.

On 25 Apr 16, there was a log jam on the Salmon River in the CSRD that caused some flooding to a barn and rental house.

On 26 Apr 16, there was a flooding incident at Tin Horn Creek in the OSRD where sand and sandbags were provided to the property owner.

On 27 Apr 16, the City of Merritt activated their EOC to Level 1 in support of potential flooding from the Nicola River.

On 27 Apr 16, Oliver had a weir open from the channel which caused flooding for 1 property.

### **URBAN INTERFACE FIRES**

On 01 May 16, the NEA PREOC activated in support of three urban interface fires in the Peace River Regional District, including an interface fire impacting First Nations lands.

### **ROCKSLIDE**

On 26 Apr 16, a task number was issued to Fraser Valley Regional District in regards to a rockslide incident on Mount Hope. Hwy 3/5 and the Trans Mountain Pipeline passing through the area were not affected.
