WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 4 – 10 April 2016

DANGEROUS GOODS

On April 4, 2016 a tractor trailer tanker carrying 48,000 litres of diesel fuel was involved in an motor vehicle incident and went down an embankment on Highway 3 near Manning Park. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status), due to the potential environmental impact.

FLOODING

On 6 April 2016 a mud slide occurred in Kamloops which required 2 families to be evacuated and provided 2 nights of accommodation and meals.

On 8 April 2016 Lee Creek in Summerland overflowed its banks and flooded 2 vacation homes. The local Emergency Program Coordinator (EPC) arranged with local Fire Chief for a sand berm along the banks of the creek to prevent further flooding.

On 9 April 2016, the water level of Allison Lake was rising and posing a risk of flooding Highway 5A due to a blockage at the lake outlet. Highways attended to try and prevent the flooding while the Okanagan-Similkameen Regional District (RDOS) continued to monitor the situation.

On April 10, 2016 the CTL PREOC in Kamloops was issued a task number to for tracking costs due to Spring Freshet response activities.
