BODY RECOVERY

On 12 Aug 16, Prince George SAR responded to recover a body from near Red Rock on the Fraser River.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 13 Aug 16, Catalyst Paper in Crofton reported a misting release into the air of an unknown amount of water soluble cooking liquor, due to a failed coupling. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) to trigger additional notifications, with an immediate downgrade.

INTERFACE FIRE

On 11 Aug 16, the Emergency Program Coordinator (EPC) in the Columbia Shuswap Regional District activated the EOC in support of multi-agency response to a house fire that displaced one family and spread to the surrounding forest in the Sunnybrae area. 4 local Fire Departments and the BC Wildfire Service actioned the fire and managed to knock it down.
