**WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Dec 19 – 25, 2016**

**DANGEROUS GOODS (CODE 2)**

On 20 Dec, a spill of used oil from a shore holding tank leaked to ground and subsequently into Seymour Creek and the ocean. Incident was raised to Code 2 for notification purposes after MOE RO arrived to find amount was significantly more than had been originally reported.

On 23 Dec, a Condensate tank belonging to Cequence Energy caught fire 200 Km from Fort St John. Incident was raised to Code 2 for notification purposes and then downgraded once the MOE RO had found out that the fire had burned itself out.

**ENVIRONMENTAL**

On 20 Dec, District of Invermere opened an incident on Industrial Road due to Toby creek flooding and affecting at least one residence and threatening the sewage treatment plant.

**POWER OUTAGE**

On 22 Dec, the EPC for Kitkatla opened an EOC and warming centre for the community due to a power outage that was entering its second day.
