MISCELLANEOUS

On 26 Dec 16, Emergency Social Services was provided for 17 people due to flooding in the residence caused by vandalism to the water lines in a house in Surrey.

On 31 Dec 16, Nanaimo Fire Dept responded to assist BCAS with a despondent individual in the South Forks Road area of Nanaimo.

On 31 Dec 16, Comox Valley SAR were requested by the RCMP to assist with rescuing a dog that had fallen down a cliff at the Hornby Island bluffs. 11 SAR members were stood down while responding as the Fire Dept advised they were qualified for high angle rescue and could perform the operation without assistance.

On 31 Dec 16, City of Vancouver advised they had activated their EOC in relation to New Year's events.
