### **ENVIRONMENTAL**

On 09 Dec 16, Golden opened their Emergency Operations Centre to level 1 due to an ice jam on the Kicking Horse River.

On 09 Dec 16, Fraser Fort George Regional District opened their EOC to level 1 due to an ice jam at Dome Creek.

On 09 Dec 16, Prince George opened their EOC to level 1 due to an ice jam at Dome Creek. An overflight was arranged by Ministry of FLNRO to assess the situation.

On 10 Dec 16, Kootenay Boundary Regional District responded and activated their EOC to level 1 in response to an ice jam on the West Kettle River, 1 km south of Beaverdell.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

On 09 Dec 16, Nanaimo Regional District called with regards to a seniors facility having its roof collapse due to rain and snowmelt. Residents were transported to the hospital by ambulance and BCAS requested assistance in transporting an additional 22 ambulatory residents to hospital as well.

On 09 Dec 16, North Shore Emergency Management requested a task number when burst pipes impacted 3 households at Seymour River Place in North Vancouver. A task was issued to have ESS volunteers investigate, however no ESS assistance was required for the residents, as they all had places to stay.
