DANGEROUS GOODS

On 01 Feb 16, there was a two liter spill of diesel at Ogden Point, Victoria. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status) for notification purposes and potential media attention.

LANDSLIDE

On 05 Feb 16, a landslide occurred in the town of Alert Bay. A house was knocked off its foundation and a family of 6 was displaced. The sewer system was compromised and a sewer pipe was severed. A geotech was obtained to conduct an assessment and ESS was provided for the family.

STORM

On 03 Feb 16, a task number was issued for an EOC activation for the City of Richmond on August 29, 2015 during a severe storm event.
