DANGEROUS GOODS

On 09 Feb 16, there was a report of an oil spill to the marine from a vessel near the grain elevators in North Vancouver. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status) for notification purposes and potential media attention. The incident was downgraded once Western Canada Marine Response and City of North Vancouver attended and confirmed there was no visible slick.
