BODY RECOVERY

On 13 Jul 16, Chilliwack SAR responded at the request of the Coroner to recover a body from the Hope Slough in Chilliwack.

On 15 Jul 16, Terrace SAR assisted the Coroner and recovered a body from a plane crash near Mount Edziza.

FLOODING

On 15 Jul 16, there was a flooding incident in Topley. Local flooding cut off access to one home occupied by a single person. Accommodation was provided for the individual.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 15 Jul 16, BCAS requested assistance from Kersley Fire Dept and Quesnel Fire Dept to access 2 adults who were suffering from suspected carbon monoxide poisoning.

On 15 Jul 16, a seasonal task was generated to cover Structure Protection Unit deployments in support of the BC Wildfire Services.

On 16 Jul 16, North Shore Rescue responded to rescue an individual's dog that had fallen 150' down an embankment on the Howe Sound Crest Trail. SAR members rappelled down and brought the dog up in a harness. The dog had no major injuries.

On 17 Jul 16, Agassiz Fire Dept was issued a task number as the Coastal Fire Centre asked them to provide water supply to help fight a forest fire near the Bear Creek Campground on Harrison East Forest Service Road.
