WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 04 – 10 Jul 2016

BODY RECOVERY

On 08 Jul 16, Mission SAR members responded at the request of the Coroner, to recover a body in Stave Lake.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 10 July 16, there was a report of a barge dumping soil into the ocean west of Vancouver. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) for dissemination purposes, with an immediate downgrade.

INTERFACE FIRE

On 03 July 16, a large brush fire occurred in Burns Bog in Delta. The fire was actioned by BCWS, Delta Fire and Metro Vancouver Parks crews. The fire jumped Highway 17 and there was a concern that it would threaten structures in the Tilbury Industrial Park, which was tactically evacuated. Delta FD contained the fire and no structures were lost. Delta activated their EOC for several operational periods to support site response and the Corporation of Delta declared a State of Local Emergency. At its peak, the response consisted of over 100 firefighters on the ground.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 04 July 16, there was a small landslide 400 meters behind a home in Williams Lake. The home was not damaged. An environmental assessment was performed by FLNRO and it was determined that there was no imminent danger.

On 07 July 16, the North Shore Emergency Management activated their EOC to level one following reports of multiple structure fires on Twin Island in Howe Sound. One home was a vacation property and one was under construction. All owners and residents were accounted for and no ESS services were required. Coastal Fire bucketed the area and RCMSAR 2 supported the District of North Vancouver.
