DANGEROUS GOODS

On 15 Mar 16, the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised an incident regarding a tug and barge gone aground near Campbell River to Code 2 (urgent status) because of potential media attention and the potential threat to the environment.

FLOOD

On 14 Mar 16, the Okanagan Similkameen Regional District (RDOS) activated in response to flooding on Saw Mill Road in Oliver.

SEVERE STORM

On 14 Mar 16, the District of North Vancouver were provided a task number for an activation in response to a severe wind storm that went through the area on Aug 29, 2015.

On 15 Mar 16, the City of Abbotsford were provided a task number for an activation in response to a severe wind storm that went through the area on 29 August.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 15 Mar 16, the Columbia Shuswap Regional District (CSRD) activated their EOC in support of MOH providing a water advisory in response to chemical spill from Canoe Forest Products into Shuswap Lake.
