**WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 28-31 March 2016**

**DANGEROUS GOODS (CODE 2)**

On March 29, 2016 the Victoria Fire Department reported that a natural gas line had ruptured causing a leak in the Industrial area of Victoria. Residences and businesses in the area from Burnside to Douglas Street on Alpha including the Galloping Goose Trail were evacuated until the line was repaired. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) until Fortis affected repairs to stop the leak and the Fire Department rescinded the evacuation order.
