WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 02 – 08 May 16

DANGEROUS GOODS CODE 2

On 05 May 16, Tervita activated their Emergency Response Plan, shut in the facility and evacuated their personnel from the landfill and fluid facility on Beaton Road near Buick for the third time in three weeks due to the existing highway closures resulting from the Blueberry River Interface Fire (G80046). The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) for dissemination purposes, with immediate downgrade.

On 08 May 16, a 150 foot by 60 foot barge owned by Vancouver Island Pile and Dredge, containing 20,000 liters of diesel fuel, washed ashore in Plumper Bay, Esquimalt Harbour. The diesel tank was punctured and spilled into the marine. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO who attended the site.

ENVIRONMENT

On 03 May 16, a magnitude 2.4 earthquake occurred near the Squamish area. A task number was issued after receiving a report of river levels dropping in the area. Squamish Lillooet Region District and FLNRO flew over the area to assess possible water level changes and no changes were observed.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 04 May 16, Merritt Fire Rescue responded to a BCAS request to assist BCAS in carrying a patient up a hill at Aspen Grove.

On 07 May 16, the Kamloops EPC received a query in regards to Kamloops taking in 400-600 members of the Fort Mackay First Nations Band that were under Evacuation Alert from the Fort McMurray Fire. It was later decided by Red Cross that they would house the affected people within Alberta.

URBAN INTERFACE FIRE

On 02 May 16, The Doig River First Nation issued an evacuation alert due to the Siphon Creek Road interface fire (G80107).

On 04 May 16, an incident was opened for the Peace River Regional District due to an interface fire (G80107) burning 2 kms north of the Doig River First Nations.

On 04 May 16, an incident was opened in the Peace River Regional District in response to an interface fire (G80130) burning around Mile 80 of the Alaska Highway. An Evacuation Alert was issued for 8 residences in the immediate area.

On 08 May 16, the Fraser Valley Regional District EPC requested the assistance of the Kent-Harrison SAR team to utilize their SAR boat to obtain situational awareness on an wildfire burning on the west shore of Harrison Lake, as forestry crews were unable to assess the site until first light.
