WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 09–15 MAY 2016

BODY RECOVERY

On 14 May 16, Vernon SAR was requested to assist RCMP in a body recovery on the Great Canal Trail near Vernon.

On 15 May 16, Penticton SAR responded for a body recovery in Trout Creek near Penticton.

DANGEROUS GOODS (CODE 2)

On 10 May 16 there was an MVI with a semi-trailer carrying batteries just outside of Jaffray, BC. The battery acid spilled to the ground and created a potential inhalation hazard. The Ministry of Environment Spill Response Officer upgraded the spill to a 'Code 2 – urgent status due to the fact that the highway was closed down for a period of time. The acid was subsequently neutralized.

ENVIRONMENT

On 12 May 16 a mudslide was reported at 7545 Dallas Drive in Kamloops. A hillside above the address eroded and created a slide that flowed towards several homes. The slide was twenty feet wide and was about two hundred feet from the houses.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 14 May 16 Chilliwack SAR to provided rope assistance to the RCMP to investigate human remains located down an embankment in Chilliwack.

FLOODING

On 11 May 16, a task number was issued to track Indigenous and North Affairs Canada (INAC) costs related to flood response for First Nations communities in the Central (CTL) Region.

On 11 May 16 localized flooding resulted in the need for sand and sand bags for up to 9 homes at the Adams Lake Indian Bands IR4 in the Chase area.

On 11 May 16 localized flooding resulted in the need for sand and sand bags for up to 9 homes at the Adams Lake Indian Bands IR5 in the Chase area.

On 12 May 16 localized flooding resulted in the need for sand and sand bags for up to 2 homes at the Adams Lake Indian Band IR6 in the Salmon Arm area, and for sand and sand bags for up to 9 homes on the Adams Lake Indian Band IR4 in the Chase area.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 13 May 16, Kamloops SAR responded to RCMP request for assistance for a dog that fell down an embankment at Napier Lake near Kamloops while hiking with its owner.

On 13 May 16, Tofino Fire Rescue responded outside of their jurisdiction for a 68 year old female hiker who fell over an embankment and was unconscious and required immediate medical attention.
