WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 24 – 30 Oct 2016

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 24 Oct 16, a tanker truck (B train) carrying a total of 50,000 liters of diesel fuel was involved in an MVI, 2 kilometres west of Hedley on Highway 3. 400 liters of diesel fuel leaked from the first tanker spilling to the highway and flowing to the Similkameen River. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status), due to the environmental impact.

On 25 Oct 16, a CP Rail train derailed on the CN rail line outside of Yale. The derailment was suspected to be due to a slide on the tracks. Nine open-topped hopper cars containing grain derailed, and went down the embankment toward the Fraser River. Five of the grain cars contents were spilled. An unknown amount of grain entered the river. Containment booms were placed along the shoreline adjacent to the incident. Both locomotives also derailed but remained upright and no fuel was released. The location of the derailment made access to the site for clean-up and recovery efforts difficult, until the track was rebuilt. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status), due to potential environmental impacts and heightened media attention.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 27 Oct 16, ESS Penticton responded to set up a Reception/Warming Center for 14 people evacuated due to a Police incident at a Motel on Skaha Lake Road.

On 28 Oct, 8 Kelowna Fire Rescue members responded to rescue a dog trapped in a hole on Highway 97 North.

On 29 Oct 15, ESS was provided for a family of 5 that was flooded out of their home due to a water main break in the Abbotsford area.

On 29 Oct 15, two days of ESS coverage was provided for a family of 6 and their tenant when their home was flooded due to a water main break in the Burnaby area.
