WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 31 Oct – 6 Nov 2016

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 05 Nov 16, a natural gas leak in Kamloops caused the evacuation of 8 people from their homes. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) and a warming centre was opened for the evacuees until the repairs on the gas line were completed and residents were allowed to return to their homes.

On 06 Nov 16, a 235 foot barge carrying gravel capsized north of Swansen Point near Hartley Bay. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the MOE RO with immediate downgrade to Code 1 due to media sensitivity.

FLOODING

On 03 Nov 16, a task was generated to track INAC costs associated with flood response for affected First Nations communities in the Vancouver Island Region.

On 03 Nov 16, the Tseshaht First Nations was impacted by flooding from the Somass River. An EOC was activated to assist with flood response activities which included sandbagging and evacuations.

On 03 Nov 16, Alberni/Clayoquot Regional District was issued a task related to flood response activities for City of Port Alberni, Beaver Creek, Sproat Lake, and Cheery Creek.

On 03 Nov 16, Comox Valley Regional District requested a task number to activate their EOC in preparation for flooding from the Puntledge River.

On 03 Nov 16, Strathcona Regional District requested sandbags in preparation for the Oyster River flooding.

On 04 Nov 16, the city of Campbell River activated an EOC to coordinate flood response activities which included door to door notice to residents along the Campbell River and pre-deployment of sandbags.

On 04 Nov 16, a task number was issued for the VIR PREOC in support of several local authority EOC's that were activated and engaged in flood response activities.

On 06 Nov 16, the District of Tofino requested a task number to prepare for potential flooding from the forecasted storm.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 05 Nov 16, a task number was provided for Kamloops ESS to open a warming centre to shelter 8 people evacuated due to a natural gas leak.

POWER OUTAGE

On 04 Nov 16, Kitkatla First Nations was issued a task number to cover fuel costs for their community generators, during a power outage, that resulted from a severe storm.
